Michael "Mike" Lemoi was born in Rhode Island to Mary and Peter Lemoi on the 30th of April 1945. He joined the Air Force in 1963 and received training as a 32152 Weapons Control Systems Mechanic. Mike retrained as a T32470 Precision Measuring Equipment Technician from March 1967 through February 1968 at Lowry AFB, CO. Including a one-year tour of duty in Vietnam from February 1968-1969, Mike served as a PMEL technician for 16 years in PMEL laboratories as well as having been selected to perform instructor duties at Lowry AFB's Avionics School of Metrology. His noteworthy participation in creating content for and teaching the USAF's newest -15 Digital Electronics for advanced technicians was a highlight of his career. Mike retired from the USAF in 1983 while stationed at Lowry AFB, Denver CO, remaining in Aurora where he then went to work for Raytheon from which he also retired. Mike was then employed as a PMEL technician in Phoenix AZ before returning to Aurora, CO to work for Frontier Airlines. Mike's last employment was with ITEC where he worked until his passing of natural causes on 17 October 2023.
